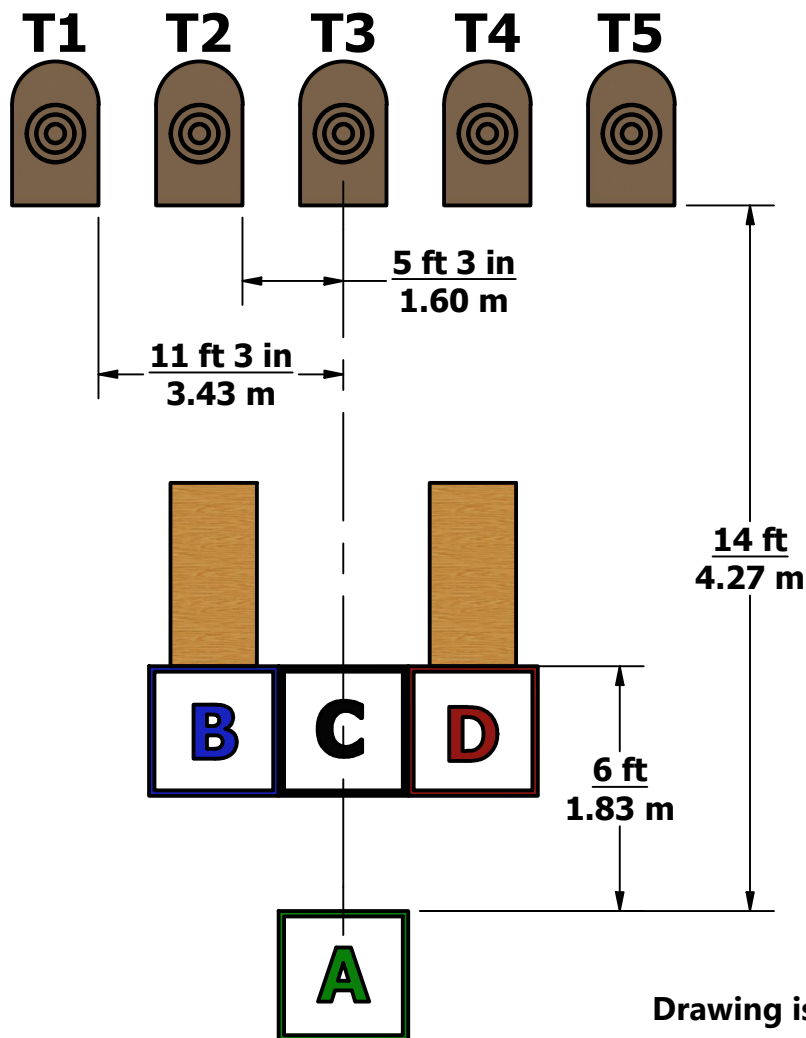




# Boxes and Barricades

**Starting Position:** Standing in Box A, facing downrange, revolver loaded and holstered, wrists below belt.

**Procedure:** At start signal, from Box A engage only T1, T3, and T5 with only two (2) rounds each in any order. From Box B engage only T1 and T2 with only two (2) rounds each in any order. From Box C engage only T2, T3 and T4 with only two (2) rounds each in any order. From Box D engage only T4 and T5 with only two (2) rounds each in any order. Order of Boxes B, C and D is shooter's choice. One continuous string.

**Scoring:** Shots Limited

**Targets:** 5 NRA D-1 paper

**Rounds:** 20 maximum

**Start:** Audible

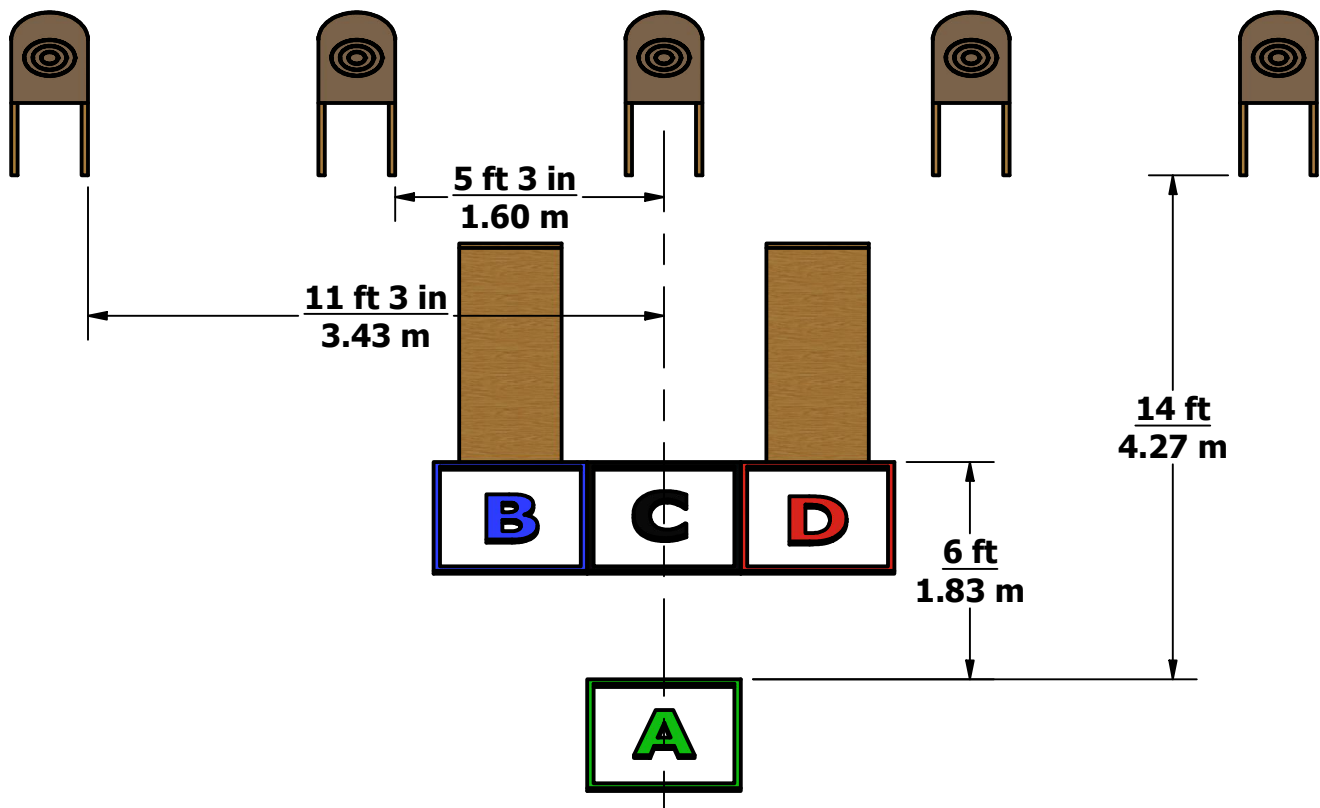
**Stop:** Last shot

**Penalties:** Per the ICORE rulebook. Foot faults, extra shots, extra hits, procedurals and misses +5 seconds per occurrence.

**Stage Setup:** Set targets T1 thru T5 at standard height with top of target 5 ft 6 in (1.68 m) +/- 2 in (5 cm) from ground. Barricades are 2 ft (0.61 m) wide, minimum. Shooting boxes are approximately 3 ft x 3 ft (1 m x 1 m). \*Barricade is a standard Bianchi barricade: 24 in W x 72 in H (0.61 m width x 1.83 m height).
