DO THIS

- Keep the good spirit of this match ... use the honor system with your set-up and scores!
- Only use current ICORE Rule Book (1 Jan 2022). http://icore.org/rulebook.phtml
- Enter correct classification from website. http://icore.org/searchclass.phtml
- Unclassified = non-members or expired members.
- Only submit revolver scores.
- Enter ALL Special Recognition Categories that apply to each shooter.
- Shoot the IPM as many times as you want.
- Shoot as many different Divisions as you want.
- Only shoot each Division once per day.
- Enter results on pre-formatted .xls spreadsheet provided. Whatever you type in will be autoformatted. Use abbreviations shown. Scores will appear with 2 decimal places. See sample entry.

2022 ICORE IPM

- Submit scores for all 4 stages on the same spreadsheet. Clubs that cannot set up 4 stages on the same day may split up the stages and shoot them on different days.
- Submit scores by Friday, January 14, 2023, to <u>ipm2022@icore.org</u>.
- Be safe and have fun.

DO NOT DO THIS

- Do not submit scores for non-revolvers.
- Do not shoot the same Division more than once per day.
- Do not alter the spreadsheet.
- Do not enter an old classification.

AWARDS

HOW WILL WINNERS BE DETERMINED?

- (1) Results will first be sorted to show the tentative winners.
- (2) Classifications and Membership Status of those will be checked.
- (3) Any incorrect winners will be voided.
- (4) Final results will be published with the correct shooters awarded.
- (5) Match closing date will be used to determine correct classification and member status.
